Dana Levin says she creates “an image that offers an immediate visual impression, which slowly, over time, unfolds on levels deeper than the surface of the canvas. I want to communicate a sense of poetry that allows viewers to access their imagination, to transcend their everyday lives, and reconnect with the rest of humanity.” Levin paintings, predominately portraits and still life bring this quote to life.

Seeking to enhance her artistic abilities and proficiency, Levin then moved to Italy to learn the techniques of the European masters at the Florence Academy of Art. She completed the three-year curriculum and upon graduation was asked to join the school’s drawing and painting faculty for the next five years and is considered to be among one of their most important alumni.

Levin’s search for meaningful subjects for her paintings has taken her throughout the United States, Eastern and Western Europe, the Middle East, and South America. Additionally, she has been awarded numerous prizes and scholarships from many organizations. Her work has also been published in several prestigious catalogues and magazines.
